

- On first use link university card to account
- Top up using credit/debit card at <https://pcas.bodleian.ox.ac.uk> (or select  icon on library PCs)
- Remember scanning is FREE!



Oxford subscribes to a wide range of e-resources, e-journals and e-books to support your research and study. Use of these is governed strictly by licence agreements.


Remember:

# SOLO – Summary: getting hold of the book you need

## Summary: getting hold of the book you need

1. Look for copies in your subject library and college library which show both 'Item in place' and 'Loanable'
2. If there are none, click 'Request' and look for a "Borrow From" option in the list of delivery locations
3. If there are no In Place items and no Borrow From options, then it is likely the only copy available to you is a copy from offsite storage


